South Jersey Gas employees carry identification cards that display their photo, full name, employee number, signature, and company logo.

“To ensure customers’ safety, we advise residents to ask all utility workers to show their IDs,” said Jeffrey DuBois, president of South Jersey Gas. “All South Jersey Gas employees carry or wear official identification cards. Any South Jersey Gas employee who needs to enter a home will gladly present his or her identification card for customer review.”

Residents will also know South Jersey Gas employees by their trucks and uniforms.
