That Petition was modified and refiled on October 9, 2020. The Project will operate in excess of 250 psig within 100 feet of 231 buildings intended for human occupancy. Owners and residents of these buildings have received personal notice. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:7-1.4, the Project will comply with 49 CFR 192.
